Dear Families

We are thrilled that the City of Melbourne have committed to our children's furniture and equipment upgrade and approved our Children's Furniture Upgrade grant application.

The total grant approved is \$9083.00.

As part of this upgrade we have purchased 12 new ergonomic cots.

The ergonomic cots will support a reduced number of injuries in relation to manual handling and particularly in multiple skeletal injuries for our staff.

The cots have arrived and we are calling for volunteers to assist us with assembling our new cots and disassembling our old ones. Please see our community chalkboard for more information on how you can assist.
